VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECKS

The Beaverton School District requires background checks for all volunteers. The process is very easy. The electronic form is encrypted and, once checked by Public Safety, the last four digits of your social security number and the year of your birth are deleted.

You only need to fill out the form once, specifying all the schools where you plan to volunteer. You may fill out the form online or on paper (school secretaries have blank copies).
