All forms, other than Form #5, must be completed for all band students.

Marching Band/Color Guard Participants - MARCHERS ONLY:

- Payment arrangements and scholarship assistance (Form #5) due by July 1, 2011. Those requesting scholarship assistance must include Form #2 as well.
- **ALL** forms and those making a full payment are due on the first Wednesday Rehearsal attended or on the first day of Band Camp (August 22).
- Marchers will not be allowed to participate in Wednesday Rehearsals or Band Camp until all forms are returned.
- Uniforms will not be issued unless payment or payment arrangements have been made and all forms are in.

Concert/Symphonic Bands, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band - NON-MARCHERS ONLY:

- Payment arrangements and scholarship assistance (Form #5) due by July 1, 2011. Those requesting scholarship assistance must include Form #2 as well.
- **ALL** forms and those making a full payment are due by September 9, 2011.
- Your student will not be allowed to go on field trips without the completion of **ALL** forms. We ask that all forms be completed for the non marching students. Completion of all the forms (including Forms B, E, and F) affords more opportunities to participate in festivals.

Three ways to return forms and payment:

- Mail to AHS Instrumental Music Program, PO Box 5571, Aloha, OR 97006, for both **MARCHERS AND NON MARCHERS**.
- Hand deliver to first attended Wednesday Rehearsal Registration table or Band Camp Registration (August 23, 2010) for **MARCHERS ONLY**.
- Hand deliver to Mr. Hymans by Friday, September 9, 2011 for **NON MARCHERS ONLY**.

Concert Dress Code for Concert, Symphonic, Jazz Bands and Wind Ensemble Participants:

The dress code is black on black, similar to many other organizations. The purpose is to “reduce distractions for the audience, so they can better focus on the music during the performance.”

Gentleman:

Black dress slacks, black socks, and black dress shoes. NO jeans and NO sneakers. A black dress shirt with collar and long sleeves. No designs or decorations on the shirt; PLAIN BLACK.

Ladies:

Black dress slacks, black socks or black tights/hose, and black blouse is preferable with black close-toed dress shoes. The blouse should have at least ¾ length sleeves; NO sleeveless or spaghetti strap tops. A modest neckline which can be achieved by wearing a black cami or t-shirt underneath. Optionally, you may choose a black skirt or black dress that is at MID-CALF or longer, which meet the criteria for sleeves and necklines. Black tights or hose. NO sequins or decorations please; as simple as possible.
