



Aloha High School Instrumental Music Program STUDENT PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

Participation in the AHS Instrumental Music Program requires that all participants know what expectations are associated with the group. Both student participants and their parents should read this agreement together to be sure that they understand the requirements of participating in the music program at Aloha High School.

EXPECTATIONS OF EACH STUDENT PARTICIPANT

1. High Academic Standards: Students must meet minimum GPA and other applicable school requirements.
2. Commitment to the Program: Practice and performance times will be clearly published on the AHS Instrumental Music Program website, www.ahsband.org.
 - ★ For marching band this will include weekly rehearsals, performances at home football games, competitions on Saturdays through mid-November. Attendance is mandatory unless permission to be absent is granted by Mr. Hymans and/or the respective section leader.
 - ★ For Wind Ensemble, Concert, Symphonic, and Jazz Bands this will include competitions and/or festivals (February through May), pep band performances, and concerts at the school. Attendance is mandatory unless permission to be absent is granted by Mr. Hymans.
3. Behavior: Each student participant MUST exhibit behavior that will create a positive and supportive environment for the AHS Instrumental Music Program. At times everyone has a bad day, however, swearing, put downs, verbal or physical abuse of any kind directed at anyone, WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. All rules listed in the Beaverton School District Consistent Discipline Handbook and all laws of our community MUST be followed. Participants must always be aware that they are representative of AHS and must exhibit positive behavior.
4. Uniform Care Responsibility: All participants in Marching Band and Color Guard are responsible for the care and maintenance of the uniform issued to them. If uniform and accessories are returned damaged, heavily soiled, or in need of excessive repair, the student will be charged for repair or replacement. The replacement cost of one uniform and accessories is in excess of \$450.
5. Instrument Care Responsibility: All students using instruments provided by the school are responsible for the care and maintenance of the instrument during the course of the school year. It is the student's responsibility to report any problems with the instrument that may occur. The student will be charged for repairs for an instrument returned to the school damaged or in need of excessive repairs.
6. Financial Commitments: All participation fees must be paid in a timely manner. All fees associated with the AHS Instrumental Music Program must be paid in full by **November 1, 2011**. Unpaid fees may result in a hold placed on class registration (9th, 10th, 11th students) or not being allowed to participate in graduation events (seniors).

*Applications must be submitted by **July 1, 2011** for all marching and non-marching band students.*

Families taking advantage of the fee payment plan are responsible for ensuring prompt payment according to the schedule outlined on the Payment Plan Form #5.

Participants are expected to purchase their own "Concert Attire." Concert attire is outlined in the band packet cover letter and on the website www.ahsband.org. Fundraising activities offer opportunities to pay for some of your next year's fees. Parents and students must understand this financial commitment to participating in AHS Instrumental Music Program.

7. Volunteering: Parents are not required but are strongly encouraged to volunteer. Students are strongly encouraged to participate in fundraising activities. It takes thousands of hours of volunteering, each year, to insure the continued success of our band programs. Remember the saying: "Many hands make light work."
