Gentlemen

Black dress slacks, black socks and black dress shoes. No jeans and no sneakers. A black dress shirt with collar and long sleeves. No designs or decorations on the shirt; plain black.

Ladies

Black dress slacks and black blouse is preferable with black dress shoes. No jeans and no sneakers. The blouse should have sleeves; no sleeveless or spaghetti strap tops. A modest neckline which can be achieved by wearing a black cami or t shirt underneath. Optionally you may choose skirts or dresses that are mid calf or longer, which meet the criteria for sleeves and necklines. No sequins or decorations please; as simple as possible.
